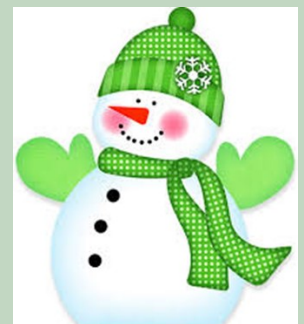

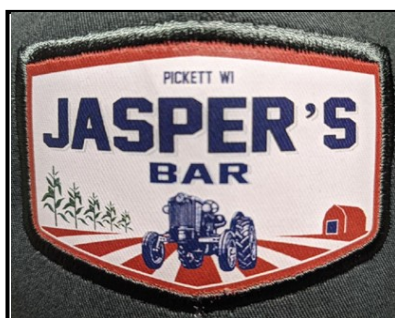
Happy New Year from all of us in the Pickett Lions Club!
