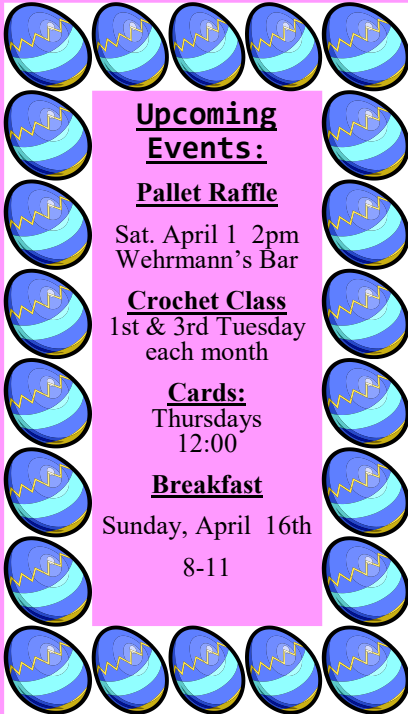

Congrats to all . The Dept. currently has 26 firefighters and 8 Emrs. Big Thank you to all who attended the PCC Breakfast in March. We served just over 100 people. It was brought up to the Town Board Members to have an additional sign mounted on residents fire number posts. Which tells the Dept. how long your driveway is in feet. This will help us Pre Plan our hose lays and truck response in the event of a fire. Some homes are not visible from the road, and have very long winding driveways, which can create problems delivering water with trucks. Trucks driving in, unloading and having nowhere to turn around to reload, and meeting other tanker trucks coming in. This creates a bottleneck effect and can slow down the fire attack considerably. The additional signs will tell us length of driveway and if there is a turnaround up near your home. The signs will be installed at no cost to the homeowner, and will be installed by the Fire Dept. After some brief discussion the Town Board approved this request. Not all residents will need this sign as some live close to the road. 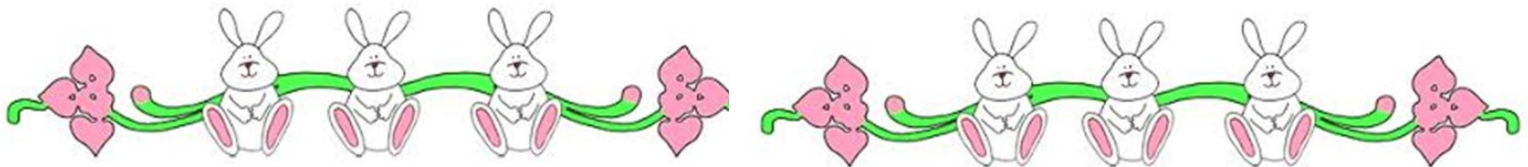

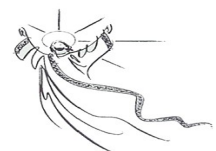
