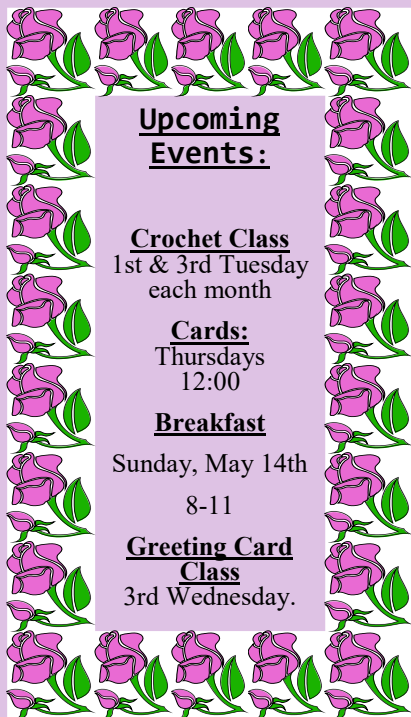

PICKETT LIONS

Lions Clubs are an international, nonprofit service organization. We have 5 Global Causes: Vision, Childhood Cancer, Environment, and Diabetes. Local clubs pay dues to state and international Lions, which are directed to these causes, but we also support them directly whenever we can.

Pickett Lions makes an annual donation to Ripon Stock the Pantries, which is a matching funds drive, supporting five area food pantries. Lions Chip Lovell and Chad Lisowe recently presented our donation check to Candie Baker at Webster's.

Pickett Lions is also supporting a relatively new program in our area. Dogs 2 Dog Tags is in the process of setting up a training facility and expanding to serve more veterans. Their mission is to save rescued, donated dogs, train them and home them with a veteran, who may be battling post combat stress and anxiety. 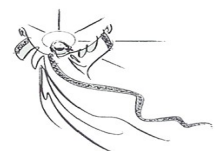
