Since 1956, the Camp, located in Rosholt, has provided quality, free summer camp experiences for Wisconsin youth and adults with disabilities, and this year's season carried on that proud tradition. Campers represented a wide range of populations: 171 campers who are Blind or Visually Impaired, 336 campers with intellectual disabilities or autism, 204 campers with diabetes, 32 campers with epilepsy, and 264 campers who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing. Each week offered opportunities for campers to build confidence, foster friendships, and enjoy an inclusive community.

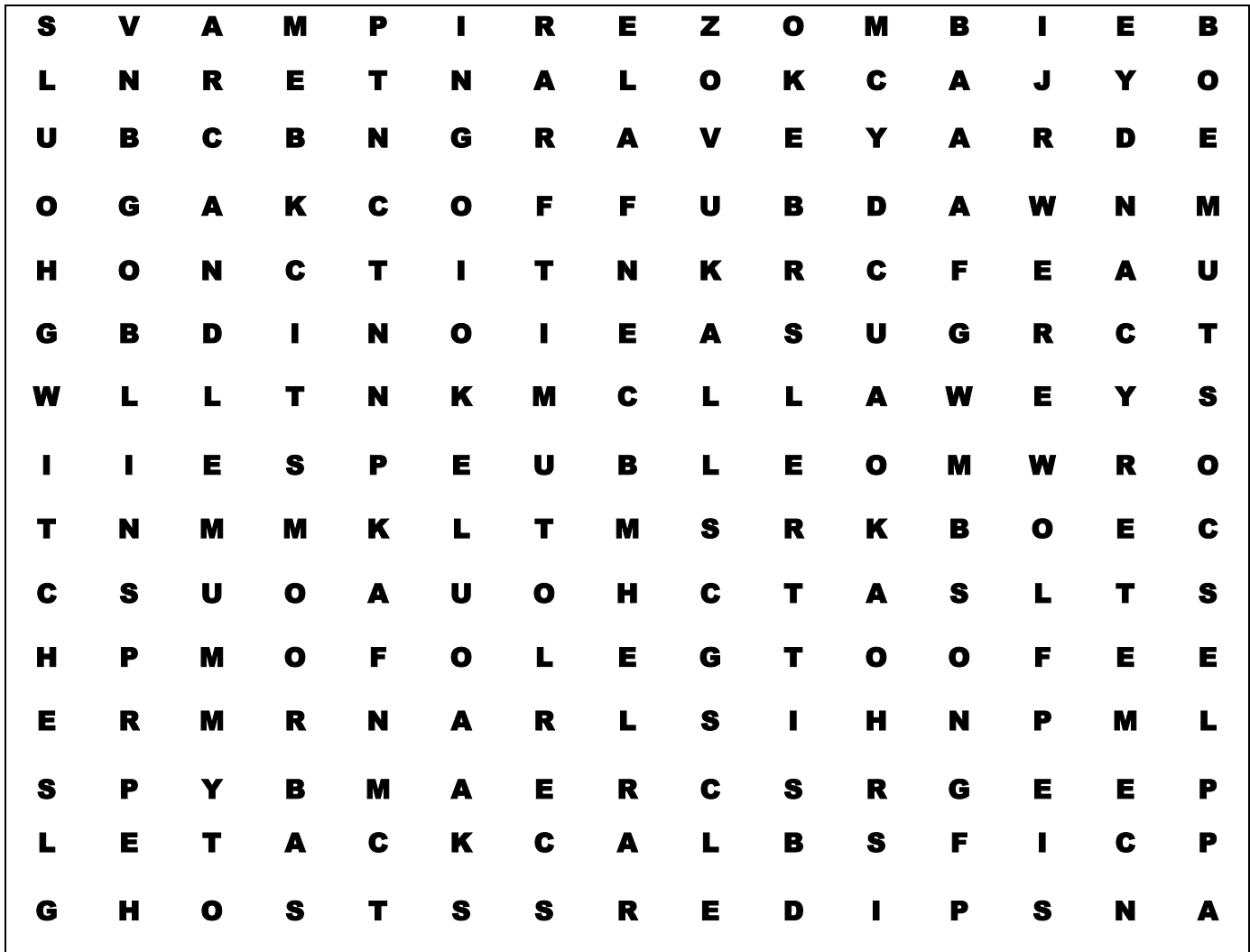
