B) 2026 ELECTION DATES: February 17, April 7, August 11, November 3 – Utica Town Hall, 1730 County Road FF in Fisk; Update your name/address, Register, Request an absentee ballot at: [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov)

C) FIRE SIGNS: When the Town of Utica installs the posts and fire signs, leave them there. They are Town property and are for your safety. If you moved/removed them, please put them back near your driveway in the ditch/culvert area in the Town’s road right-of way. Thank you! Chairman Schmick stated the signs are not designed to be moved and put in different spots. They should stay where they are so the firemen can see them when they are out at any time of day and night, or during a snowstorm. **Do not move them.**

- August 2 – 6 th : Youth who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing (ages 6 – 17)
- August 10 – 14 th : Adults who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing (ages 18+)
